

Hybrid: Students attend in person in either the a.m. or p.m. They participate in Distance Learning the other half of the day and all day on Wednesday.








Hybrid Instruction: AM/PM Cohort Model - AM Cohort

Student sits in homeroom seat for **Synchronous** learning






- Students, staff, and families wear masks

A Day in the Life (M, T, Th, F)

What we know:

- AM/PM Model
- 2 Hours 15 minutes in person learning
- Asynchronous learning and Specialists remotely from home, with supplemental small group support for some students

What we are working on:

- Recommended instructional schedule

Synchronous/Asynchronous Instruction

What we know:

- Teachers have learned what works for their students
- Instructional Frameworks provide guidance on learning activities and tasks
- Math will continue to be a priority to minimize learning gaps, but will not be the only content during in person learning

What we are working on:

- Reviewing existing frameworks to determine needed adjustments for hybrid

Wednesdays

What we know:

- No on-site instruction
- Asynchronous and some Synchronous Instruction
- Prioritized time for Teacher/Team Planning

What we are working on:

- Specific recommendations for Wednesday schedules

Transition Support and Planning

What we know:

- Time for staff transition planning will be identified prior to students being on site
- Materials and resources will be developed and available to support this planning
- TLL staff will be available to assist
