Ongoing Activities:       • Teacher works on Focused PGP (Professional Growth Plan), documents progress, and collects any related artifacts.         • Procedures related to Additional Observations and Artifact Submission are the same as for the Comprehensive Cycle.         • Mid-Year Reflection and Final Reflection         • Final Reflection due by May 15         Required Observations: after the FCC1         • Required first observation cycle, including written documentation and related conferences must be complete prior to February 1; the second must be complete prior to May 1. These observation cycles may be clustered in the first semester, clustered in the second semester, or distributed between both.         • Minimum of one scheduled observation of at least 30 minutes; may be non-continuous within a 10-workday period; will focus on the selected criterion.         • Initial written report, including initial ratings of performance in criterion components, provided to the teacher within five (5) working days of the observation (or last observation within a 10-day series).         • Teacher may submit related artifacts before/after the observation.         • As appropriate, the observations need not be limited to the classroom, but may include the observation of duties that occur outside of the classroom setting.								progress towa Professional G	• •
